## **Mangalayatan University-AFC Partner to Nurture Aviation Talent**Give Wings to Your Dreams through Aviation Course

Magalayatan University and Ambitions Flying Club (AFC) have inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to introduce B.Sc. (Aviation), a unique civil aviation course. The new course would enable youngsters to fulfill their dreams to fly as a Commercial Pilot with license (CPL) and get a degree simultaneously.

Registrar Cdr. (Retd.) Manjeet Singh and Club Director Shri Bhargav Mandavia signed MoU in a simple ceremony at Mangalayatan University on Wednesday. According to Brig. (Dr.) Surjit Pabla, Vice-Chancellor, 'Keeping aviation sector's growth in mind the University has decided to start B.Sc. (Aviation) to provide in depth theoretical and practical knowledge to the students in a comprehensive training environment. The goal of the program is to encourage high quality aviation talent in the Country. We hope that the new course

will become a major attraction for students as Indian aviation industry is growing at a very fast pace resulting in increased demand for quality aerospace personnel.'

According to the MoU, Mangalayatan University will design and implement the three years course curriculum in B.Sc. (Aviation) with a provision for skills training for Commercial Pilot License by the Club. The course will be conducted by the University as per the UGC and DGCA norms. Course design includes 200 hrs flying training by the aviation experts through AFC. Students will also have the option to choose simple B.Sc. (Aviation) course without skills training for Commercial Pilot License. Such students will be trained for other aviation sector jobs.

DPS Aligarh Pro Vice-Chairman Swapnil Jain, Dr. (Col.) Nagraj Mantha, Director, IET, Captain Rajeev Bhalla from the Club and Lecturer Ms. Firdaus Naqvi were also present on this occasion.
