In this session, the expert gave a brief description of Maurasana. He stated that this asana is also known as 'The Peacock Pose', usually performed within an expert supervision. However, those who practice the pose can gain efficiency in time. He explained that this asana requires one to lift the body in an upside down position to attain a slanting position. The expert demonstrated the asana and described its benefits from strengthening arms, shoulders and back to improving concentration.

#### **Steps as demonstrated by the Expert**

After a through introduction the resource person performed the steps by placing his **heels** close to each other and make sure that the knees are wide apart. Then, he knelt forward, placing his palms on the ground between his knees with fingers pointing towards the body. He gently bent his elbows and pressed them towards the abdomen, putting all your body weight on the hands.

#### **Benefits**

The expert expressed that the participants will be benefitted by this activity if they engage in it on a regular basis. He narrated the following benefits: peacock pose removes toxins and detoxifies the body, improves the function of digestive system and makes abdomen stronger, Peacock Pose is beneficial in piles and diabetes, strengthens and tones your reproductive system, makes your elbows, wrist, spine, and shoulders stronger, mayurasana improves the posture, reduces anxiety and stress and give calmness to the mind, increases the focusing power of the mind.

The abdominal organs are all swept up to a higher than normal position in the trunk by a partial vacuum in the chest cavity.

Sports is a major contributor to economic and social development and its role is well recognized by the government. On consensus, sports contributes to the

Moreover, the Sports Management businesses have incurred losses due to closure of sporting houses and sports events. The COVID-19 pandemic has had and will continue to have very considerable effects on the sporting world as well as on the physical and mental well-being of people around the world.

### **Recommendations:**

Governments and other national organizations may provide sports federations, clubs and organizations around the world with guidance related to safety, health, labour and other international standards and protocols that would apply to future sport events and related safe working conditions. The sport ecosystem, comprising of producers, broadcasters, fans, businesses, owners and players among others, need to find new and innovative solutions to mitigate the negative effects of COVID19 on the world of sport. Creating new operating models and venue strategies were also among the final conclusions of the webinar. 
#### **Event description:**
